Fewer copies and editions will also lead to a significant reduction in paper waste and allows for more diverse and quality content leading to a longer shelf life.

The Pulse staff is excited to produce this new product and eager to begin its transition. The talented team seeks to produce a relevant magazine for the Messiah College community.
